OVERVIEW

Module #3 – Local Strategic Planning describes the "PLAN" step in the community development process (see box to the right). Strategic planning correlates to a community thinking in a focused way about goals and strategies and how to implement an action plan.

- Following the planning process in the module effectively involves people both at the leadership level and with the public-at-large. This is a best practice for successful and competitive communities.
- Together with a community assessment, local strategic planning establishes a vision, identifies priorities and lays out a roadmap to implementation and acheivement.
- Having community leaders trained in strategic planning creates confidence in the participants of the process.
- Stakeholders, funding sources, and business investors will understand the vision and plan for creating a more competitive community.
- A completed and comprehensive community and economic development strategic plan, with the community's vision, defines the measurements a community tracks to show trends and accomplishment.
- The vision, when well communicated, gives others a story to tell about where a community is going.
